

## RACING POLICY

16<sup>th</sup> February 2011

The following policies only relate to Cycling NSW events.

**1. All members can apply to have their racing fee reimbursed.**

This includes Cycling NSW track and road events.

This also includes mountain bike races subject to the below

Receipts are to be presented to the Treasurer in September 2011

**Note:**

An overall budget is allocated for this policy

If the receipt amounts received exceed the budget then:

All races outside the Sydney metropolitan area will receive priority

Any remaining money will be distributed proportionately.

Mountain bike races will be reimbursed a maximum of \$30 per contestant per day as this is a standard CNSW entry fee amount

**2. State/Australian Championships (if only medals are awarded)**

- \$120 for Gold, \$80 Silver, \$40 Bronze for individuals

- \$240 for Gold, \$160 Silver, \$80 Bronze for teams (of 4)

**3. Targeted races will be advertised. For these events either transport will be organised or a subsidy will be provided to participating members**

If transport is organised volunteers may be sought to assist with driving

**4. An allowance will be made for cold drinks, water and snacks to be provided at targeted races**

**5. Accident Assistance**

If you happen to have a crash during a CNSW race and damage your bike, clothing, or need a new helmet, there will be a one-off allowance of up to \$200 to assist you in getting back on the road. The amount or goods will be at the race secretaries discretion.

This is in addition to any claim that can be made via Cycling NSW.

**6. Application can be made for assistance at other races and will be considered by the Race Secretary but the final decision will be entirely at their discretion**

Any decision will be ratified by the committee.

**Note:**

- to qualify for these membership benefits you must participate in the race and wear the Sydney kit

- The member must demonstrate club spirit. This demonstration should be self evident but a case can be made at the time of claim.

- All reimbursements will be made in October 2011.
